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2. The School is required to apply online for further extension of affiliation along with the required documents as per Rule 10.3 of Affiliation Bye Laws.
3. The school will also abide by the conditions prescribed, if any, by the State Government contained in certificate as per appendix III issued by District Education Officer (DEO) /equivalent officer.
4. The school should ensure the strong governance and management of its activities in way of quantifiable planning in way of curriculum planning, infrastructure, resources, physical development and other co-curricular areas.
5. The school should go through the provision of **Affiliation and Examination Bye Laws and** for reference purpose and also advised to visit CBSE websites i.e. <http://cbse.nic.in/> for updates. The School is expected to see all circulars on these CBSE web
6. The school will strictly adhere to all rules regarding safety of students including Fire fighting etc. Further, school will provide adequate facilities for potable drinking water and clean toilets with washing facilities for boys and girls separately in proportion to the number of students.
7. **Admission to the school** is to be restricted as per relevant rules of Examination Bye-laws : 7.1, 7.2, 8.4.2, 8.4.10 & other relevant rules of Affiliation bye laws.
8. The school is required to follow rule No.2.4.7 and 2.4.8 of Affiliation Bye Laws regarding Education.
9. The number of sections in the school are restricted to **19** as per number of sections reported not be increased without specific approval of the Board. For increase in number of sections apply online to the Board as per rule 15.7 of affiliation bye laws.
10. The school shall be solely responsible for any legal consequences arising out of the use of /society/trust or any other identity related to running of school affiliated to CBSE. The school shall bear all legal charges incurred by the Board, if any, arising out of these circumstances.
11. The school must strive to promote conservation of environment on their campus through segregation of waste at source, recycling of organic waste, proper disposal of waste including use of energy saving and energy efficient electrical equipment, greening of campus, and education and awareness amongst children on environment conservation and cleanliness etc.
12. The school shall submit their information through Online Affiliated School Information System details given in circular no. affiliation-06/2018 dated 24.04.2018. Link for OASIS is available [www.cbse.nic.in](http://www.cbse.nic.in).
13. The optimum Section teacher ratio of 1:1.5 as well as student teacher ratio of 30:1 is to be maintained for various subjects and school shall appoint qualified and trained teaching staff on regular basis as per Affiliation Bye Laws of the Board.
14. Every affiliated school shall sponsor regularly its bonafide and eligible students in Boards Class examinations from the year mentioned while granting affiliation/upgradation regularly without reasons thereof in writing well in time about the non-sponsoring of the candidates.
15. Running of **coaching institutions** in the school premises in the pretext of providing coaching for various examinations is not permitted by the Board. Strict action would be taken on defaulters.
16. The Manager and the Principal of the school shall be jointly responsible for the authenticity of documents/ information/data submitted by the School to the Board.
17. Apart from rules to be adhered to by the school as mentioned above for drawing specific at authorities, the school authorities are required to acquaint themselves with all the rules contained in Examination Bye-laws and circulars/guidelines/ notification issued by the Board from time to time. Non-compliance with following rules/instructions of the Board will lead to action against school as per Chapter 15 of Bye-laws-2018.
18. The school shall be responsible to comply immediately with the conditions mentioned in the bye-laws. The school shall also maintain record of certificates, compliances, data and other records/information and shall be responsible to produce all such records before Board when asked for failing which necessary action will be taken as per Affiliation Bye Laws.
